

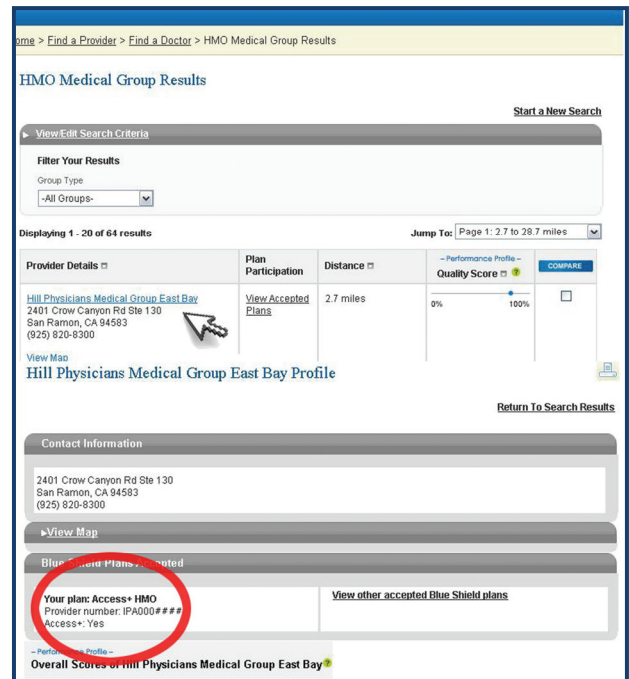
## Selecting Hill Physicians with Blue Shield\*

During **Open Enrollment**, your HMO will ask you to select a **Primary Care Provider**, or PCP. When you make that selection, you'll be asked for the doctor's **Identification Number**. This is a unique number that not only identifies the doctor; it also indicates his or her medical group affiliation. Some doctors have several numbers so look for the one that enrolls you with Hill Physicians. If you don't, your HMO may assign you to another medical group. Although this will not affect your plan's benefits, it may impact your overall experience because medical groups provide different resources and have different administrative procedures.

**Finding Physician and Medical Group ID Numbers:** The steps and images below will guide you through selecting a doctor, highlighting how and where to find PCP and Medical Group ID Numbers necessary on your enrollment forms.

1. Visit **BlueShieldca.com\*** and, under **I Need to Find A Provider**, click on **Find a Doctor**.
2. Identify your plan, choose "All Plans," or log-in with your membership ID to identify your plan. Then choose a **Search Category**.
3. If you choose to search by **HMO Medical Group**, select "Hill Physicians Medical Group."
  - Under **Provider Details**, you will see Hill Physicians listed as a link. Click on this link (as shown in the photo to the right).
  - You will see information on our medical group and a list of our physicians. Click on a physician's name to find the **identification numbers** which indicate his/her affiliation with your health plan and Hill Physicians Medical Group. Use these numbers on your **Change Enrollment** form.
4. If you choose **Search by Doctor Type and Specialty**, select "HMO Personal Physician."
  - Narrow your search further if desired before selecting your geography. Click **Search**.
  - You will see a list of PCPs available to you. Click on **View Accepted Plans** to see a list of the plans and medical groups with which the physician is affiliated.
  - Record the identification numbers which indicate his/her affiliation with your health plan and **Hill Physicians Medical Group** on your **Change Enrollment** form.
